

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Noel will hold a public hearing on November 21st, 2024, 6:00 p.m. at City Hall located at 201 Railroad St. Noel, MO 64854 to discuss the city's submission of an application for the Fiscal Year 2023 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The city is interested in obtaining all citizens' input on community development needs within the city. As part of the hearing process, citizens will be asked to verbally assist in the completion of a Needs Assessment document. The document will detail what the residents feel are the strengths and weaknesses of the community. In addition to the Needs Assessment, citizens will have the opportunity to discuss the impact of the proposed project on the environment and the environment's possible impact on the project. The city needs as much local participation as possible in order to reflect the true desires of the community as a whole, as well as the comments relating to the proposed project application. The State has established a maximum application request for each funding category. Activities that are eligible for funding include the improvement of public works, public facilities, housing rehabilitation, and others allowed by law. At least 51% of the funds must be used to benefit low- and moderate-income persons. No displacement of persons will be proposed. The City of Noel is proposing to enhance wastewater management for the city by constructing or upgrading a lift station facility. This project aims to manage the collection, movement, and disposal of wastewater, addressing the needs of a growing population while meeting environmental standards. The initiative tackles current infrastructure challenges by providing reliable sewage handling and improving overall sanitation for the community. Key elements of the project include the installation of advanced pumps, durable pipes, and modern control systems to ensure efficient wastewater flow. These upgrades are designed to minimize the risk of overflow or contamination, ensuring a safer and healthier environment for residents. The total cost of these renovations is \$1,334,050, which will be funded through Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. All citizens, including those in the targeted area, are encouraged to attend in order to comment on the proposed activities.
